

Did you write everything in your novel from personal experience or did you have to do a lot of research?

The scenes from "UnMasked" are drawn from personal experience or created through friends and family and then massaged to fit the character's personality. Sometimes my personal life fit well into the book and I shaped the dialogue to match the characters. For example, Granda Patti is carded on her birthday and she's over the moon excited. The same thing happened to me on the exact same birthday. I remember being overjoyed to share the news with my family and it fit well with Granda Patti's personality. In terms



of research, I had to made sure I had dates and places correct, as "UnMasked" follows a time line from January 2020 through March 2021. It's easy to mix up events, so my big take-away and tip to fellow writers is to plot the time-line in advance and have it available during the writing process.
